 - Marking music with your pencil
 - Fingering / Air Playing / Air Bowing along
- ★ You are actively creating a positive environment:
 - You are being courteous to all staff members and students at all times.
 - You are encouraging your peers to be proficient in their music
 - You are demonstrating respect and compassion when other students are performing at ALL times, regardless of abilities.
- ★ You are taking charge of your own learning:
 - You are looking up information for yourself when appropriate.
 - You are actively looking ahead in your music/book/rhythms.
- ★ You are coming to class prepared:
 - You practiced tough spots before rehearsal today.
 - Mrs. Martel is not having to reteach a section she taught the other day as you went home and practiced it.
 - You have learned your part completely so others can learn your part.
 - *Rehearsal is when you learn everyone else's part - not your own!*
- ★ You are taking care of all classroom materials:
 - Instruments are always placed in a safe spot when not in use.
 - You only touch your instrument - not others'.
 - You are only drinking water.
 - You are leaving any area of the room cleaner than you found it.
